Birth with Dignity (birthwithdignity.org) is a nonprofit that has been working in Uganda for several years focusing on still birth trauma. The current need per the Hospitals is a lack of proper lighting during the birthing process for delivery and recognizing hemorrhaging. Currently, many of the doctors and midwives are delivering using the flashlight from their cell phones. In addition, many of the pregnant women are not aware of warning signs that could reduce still births, such as high blood pressure, poor nutrition, lack of proper sleep, etc.

This project would supply dignity kits to more than 150 hospitals that include headlamps for the doctors and midwives delivering babies as well as laminated posters with pictures showing proper pre-natal care

and the warning signs of problems. This project will improve thousands of births and educate many pregnant women. Rotarians will be involved in assembling the kits, and the Host Club Rotarians will be assisting in delivery of the Kits throughout Uganda. Rotarians can also visit Uganda hospitals and see how these Dignity Kits are put into action. The Kits will include batteries for at least one year, and then the hospitals will provide future batteries.

Project Budget (expenses and funding sources)

Initial budget: Headlamps and Posters Kits \$ 14,400

Gasoline for delivery 0f Kits 1,600

Total 16,000

This initial budget estimate requires \$6,000 from at least 4 Club contributions plus \$10,000 from District 5950. The more Rotary Clubs that collaborate, the more Kits we can assemble.
