Q. How do non-Rotarians register?

They need to create a "My Rotary Account"

Q. Clarity on the Buses for Host Hospitality

Buses will be set up to carry guests and Host Club hosts to ride with them. i.e. 55 seat bus, 50 guests, 2 - 3 hosts.

Q. How do I register my "under 18 aged" children?

To add a guest that is 18 or under, guardian must fills out the paper registration form at <u>registration-and-ticket-form</u> and sign the parental consent form on the 4th page. You must email the completed form without payment information to <u>RI.Registration@rotary.org</u>. We will then register the minors and let the guardian know they may log back in to their MyRotary account to make payment.

Q. What do the volunteers need to do?

It will be given to them in the training. Mostly provide guidance and show Canadian hospitality to delegates.
