Both **Peterborough** and our partner **Pokhara Fishtail** Rotary Clubs have extensive **Global Grant experience**. This is Peterborough's **third** global grant since 2019, while Pokhara has completed **six** global grants, and dozens of large internationally-funded projects, across multiple areas of focus.

The **female club members in Pokhara** will oversee this grant project, ensuring that it truly reflects its **female-focused mission**.

Peterborough Rotarians have visited the Pokhara Club, and the training facilities. In 2024, the two clubs successfully **completed a District Grant project** at a local school, building a **girls' toilet structure** to promote hygiene, and strengthen female education opportunities. In

2025, we will use a **District Grant** to set up a **rural school computer lab**, reinforcing the two clubs' shared commitment to education and empowerment.
