

Interviews with final applicants will be arranged in late October 2025. The selected scholar will then apply for acceptance at a foreign university or college of their choosing for studies beginning Fall of 2026. The Masters program can be completed in one or two academic years, and the \$30,000 scholarship can be applied toward tuition, travel, lodging, etc. during the study period.
